Physical Education Waiver

Legislature passed Senate Bill 610 which was signed into law by Governor Crist on June 2, 2008. It included changes on the statute as it relates to physical education for students in grade K-8.

- Continues to require 150 minutes each week for students in grades K-5 and requires at least 30 consecutive minutes of physical education.
- Requires the equivalent of one class period per day of physical education for one semester of each year for students enrolled in grades 6-8 beginning in the 2009-2010 school year.
- This statute requires each district school board to notify parents of the options available in scheduling a student for physical education class. Unless your child meets one of the waiver criteria, he or she will be enrolled in physical education program.

To waive the physical education requirement for your child mark one of the criteria below (check one only):

My child is enrolled or required to enroll in a remedial course.

I request that my child enroll in another course from among those offered as options by the school district.

My child is participating in physical activities outside the school day which are equal or more than the mandated requirements.
